But let me begin with probably one of the most important victories we experienced... the GRANTING OF OUR NATURALISATION here! What that means is that Nita and I are now permanently accepted in Ireland as IRISH CITIZENS! We have been granted dual citizenship! In case you did not know, there are a lot of dark undercurrents in current European-wide legislation that would severely limit the stay of foreign missionaries here in Ireland, and throughout Europe! One missionary family was just recently sent back to the States from Ireland after just one year because of the current attitude towards religious missionaries here. Other missionaries are in a virtual state of limbo, just waiting to see what the government will decide. Then again, none are really in limbo, they are praying - and we all ask you to pray with us to change the hearts of kings and ministers to allow the free establishment of New Testament Bible Believing Baptist Churches throughout this dark continent!



Revival Meeting with Bruce Frye! Bruce and his family came and spent nine days with us in June, preaching, and singing both in church every evening, and also on the street in downtown Cork! Many new visitors were brought out to hear the Gospel, and our whole church was encouraged, and spiritually revived! Four new names were written down in glory: Christine L, Sylvia H, Gladys O, and Izek D! They couldn't wait to get saved during the heart warming preaching from the word of God! We also had a bit of warm weather at the beginning of the Revival, so three new believers were Scripturally baptized, and two
